Project aims

Report-ASAP is a 2-year project funded under the EU ERASMUS+ Strategic Partnership Programme. The aim of this project is to help SMEs become more sustainable across Europe.

As part of a European initiative to promote Corporate Social Responsibility in SMEs, the Project will help businesses complete tasks necessary to carry out sustainability accounting practices as a benefit to the company itself.

We want to do this through creating a simple yet complete training and education to help SMEs to adopt sustainability accounting and reporting practices in a cost-effective way by:

- Providing information for sustainability accounting practices and reporting awareness.
- Improving users' skills and competencies in relation to sustainability reporting, making it easier to implement these techniques.
- Increasing the visibility of the acquired skills through the lenses of ECVET provisions and providing a Skills and Achievements Recognition Framework for the completed tasks.

Our Progress So Far

We are half way through the project and are making great progress.

We have completed our **1st Output**, to provide an overview to the consortium and stakeholders of the current state of sustainability accounting practices in SMEs in the partner countries.

We are now focusing on our **2nd Output** where we've developed a structured training course including the following overarching modules:

1. Introduction to Sustainable Accounting
2. Legal national framework and EU directives
3. Social dimension of sustainability (community, employees, responsible products)
4. Environmental dimension of sustainable accounting (energy, waste management, water, pollution)
5. Economic dimension of sustainable accounting (financial & non-financial benefits)
6. Report design guidelines & internal and external communication

Our technical partner CIVIC is currently developing the online training delivery environment facilitated by a Social Learning Motivational Environment. This will be available on Moodle and will deliver the training material for learners and a trainer's guide for instructors/trainers.

The learning outcomes of the modules will be supported both by the ECVET skills framework and by an achievements recognition framework (based on the Open Badges specification).

We had our 2nd project meeting in Milan

On the 11th and 12th of April, the consortium of the Project Report-ASAP (Adoption of Sustainable Accounting for reporting), held the second meeting with partners at Eurocrea Merchant in Milan (Italy). The Project is led by Staffordshire University (United Kingdom) within the framework of the Erasmus + Programme of the European Commission.

Report-ASAP's main objective is to provide the necessary tools and training to help small and medium-sized companies adopt sustainable accounting practices. The Project focuses on three areas of sustainability: economic, social and environmental.

During the meeting the partners were updated in relation to the achievement of the main milestones of the Project as well as the progress in the organisation of the most imminent activities (for example, the development of training content on sustainable accounting practices for SMEs).

Special emphasis was placed on the results of the research phase carried out by the partners and the production of the Comparative Report by the team of the Fundación General Universidad de Granada-Empresa. The partners shared the similarities and differences found between countries. [The European Report is available here.](#)

In general, the meeting held in Milan was very productive for the progress of the project. In addition, it was an incentive to continue with the commitment and motivation of the consortium with a view to acquiring the next results of Report-ASAP.
